This exhibition "Indian Summer" will exhibit Fine Art + Photography from the Robin Rice Gallery including Rice's own fine art photography. The show will be on exhibit beginning Friday October 9th, with an opening reception Saturday October 10th from 5pm to 8pm. The first Sunday Salon in the garden will be Sunday October 11th from 3pm to 5pm, with artist + fine art photographer Luciana Pampalone.

La Plage is a social impact store that sells artwork, home decor, and lifestyle brand merchandise designed to help clients improve their lives for the better. The store was founded this year by Abby Drucker. She spent the lockdown in East Hampton, NY and saw the pandemic's impact on local residents firsthand. So, with a commitment to act local, but think global, she established La Plage to support artists and female-owned businesses, as well as give back to the community. The business model offers an approachable price range for everyone. La Plage also donates 10% of sales to local non-profit organizations such as Robin Hood, Urban Arts Partnership, The Ross School for scholarships and JBL Soul Foundation.

Born in Brooklyn, Abby Drucker is an art collector and an avid supporter of arts education. She is currently a Wall Street trader and a 30 year resident of Sag Harbor. After meeting Robin Rice in Bridgehampton, who used to be a longtime resident, Drucker became a longtime supporter of The Robin Rice Gallery. She loves the gallery's annual Summertime Salon and wishes to create a similar experience. The opening weekend will also coincide with the Hamptons Film Festival. On Sunday, October 11th, the first Sunday Salon of an ongoing artist series will be with Luciana Pampalone.

Luciana Pampalone is an Award Winning Visual Image Specialist with experience around the globe. After graduating from School of Visual Arts, she became a sage of the art world who went on to work in content creation, artistic direction, fashion travel photography, and interior design during the span of her long career. Her approach takes on a multi-dimensional perspective and has rendered impressive bodies of work within various mediums. In recent years, she built up a following on social media and became a creative influencer.

These salons are meant to bring people together and foster connection. Stop by the garden at La Plage for a glass, a nibble, a conversation.
